

Registration terms & conditions

Payment

All costs referred to are in Euros (€). All payments must be made in Euros; no other currency will be accepted. Full payment is due for the registration fees. Registrations are only confirmed once the required payment has been received.

Payment by credit card

The online registration platform is a secured site on which you can pay by credit card. Please note that VISA, MasterCard and AMEX are the only credit cards accepted. Please enter all relevant information on the registration form. Upon completion of the online registration process, you will receive a paid invoice (receipt) by email.

Payment by bank transfer

Should you select to pay by bank transfer, upon completion of the online registration process, you will receive an outstanding invoice for your registration fees by email. This invoice includes all payment instructions as well as your registration number to mention as reference of the payment. Until payment is received in full, the registration will be held on “optional” status and cannot be confirmed.

Invoice

Only digital versions of invoices (PDF) will be sent to delegates upon completion of the online registration. The invoice will be issued using the contact details provided on the registration form so please make sure you have provided us with the correct information.

Cancellation of registration

Cancellation must be done in writing to Symposium@ipfa-events.nl, and confirmed by the IPFA Secretariat. The following cancellation fees apply:

- In case of cancellation **before or on 9 January 2026 (23:59 CET)**, the registration fee will be refunded with a deduction of 50% as penalty charge.
- **As of 10 January 2026**, the registration fee will not be refunded for cancellations or no-shows.

If, for reasons beyond the control of secretariat the event has to be cancelled, the registration fee will be refunded after deduction of expenses incurred by the secretariat.
